SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT:

- 1. See Information to the Board
- 2. Dr. Robertozzi reported on the following:
 - First he welcomed Mrs. Villani to the Board and congratulated Mr. Alvarez and Mr. Topoleski on their reelection. He also congratulated Mr. Russell and Mrs. Hudak on their election as President and Vice President.

- We currently have student exchange trips with five different countries; Germany, Spain, China, Italy and France. In light of the recent terror attack in France, some people were wondering if the Board would continue to support student exchanges. It is his opinion and recommendation that we continue exchange trips. If parents are willing to send their child then he will be willing to make the recommendation to the Board to continue these trips. Dr. Robertozzi asked for feedback and the consensus was that the trips should continue.
- At the last Board Meeting in November, a parent requested that the Board look into designating our district a "peanut-free district". He asked the Head Nurse, Joyce Hirsch, to look into that request. Her response noted that peanut butter, for some students, is a very nutritious and economical snack. She found that there were approximately 89 students in the district with a peanut allergy. She also found, however, that there were almost the same amount with tree nut allergies. She recommended that we create a "food allergy awareness zone". There are also other steps to take by communicating with teachers and other parents. Discussion ensued. The Policy Committee will look into this if they wish to go that route.
- A petition was distributed to the Board from a group of parents requesting that a snack be served to students either before or after lunch, depending on what time lunch is served. Discussion again ensued. The policy committee will look into this further.

The Attorney Committee, upon recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, presents the following motion to the Linden Board of Education for approval:

1. Approve the following Settlement Agreement:

The Linden Board of Education hereby approves the Settlement Agreement and General Release between it and the City of Linden in the matter docketed as UNN-L-1441-13 and authorizes the Superintendent and Business Administrator to take the appropriate actions necessary to effectuate this resolution and the terms of the Settlement Agreement and General Release upon receipt of a fully executed Agreement from the City.
