
LPS and Donors Choose Announce New District Partnership



Middle Grades Career Grant Award

The Linden Public Schools received the Middle Grades Career Awareness and Exploration Grant Award for the 2021-2022 school year in the amount of \$68,992. This funding will be allocated for three years at \$206,976 total. The objective of the grant is to cultivate the development of career awareness and exploration programs focused on engaging career-focused instruction and unique experiences for students in grades five through eight. Activities through the grant

award will increase students' awareness of career and technical education (CTE) opportunities and the NJ Key Industry Pathways.



21st Century Community Learning Center

The Linden Public Schools received the 21st Century Community Learning Center Grant Award from the NJDOE for the 17th year in a row. This \$425,000 grant award provides an extended learning day to the secondary students at Soehl Middle School. Program offerings include homework assistance, stem, enrichment, recreation, mentoring, community service and much more.
