The Finance Committee, upon recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools and the Business Administrator/Board Secretary, present the following motions to the Linden Board of Education for approval:

1. BE IT RESOLVED that the TENTATIVE budget be approved for the SY2023-2024 using the SY2023-2024 state aid figures and the School Business Administrator/Board Secretary be authorized to submit the TENTATIVE budget to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools for approval in accordance with the statutory deadline, as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a public hearing be held at the Linden Board of Education meeting located at the gymnasium at School 1, 728 North Wood Avenue, Linden, NJ 07036 on April 27, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. for the purpose of conducting a public hearing on the budget for the SY2023-2024.

Appropriation of <u>SURPLUS</u>

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education includes in the tentative budget an appropriation of surplus designated as legal reserve in the amount of $\frac{14,243,640}{14,243,640}$.

MAXIMUM TRAVEL

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.3, a board of education must establish a maximum dollar limit for travel expenditure, as defined in N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.1 et seq.,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education includes in the tentative budget a maximum travel expenditure in the amount of

\$250,000.00 for SY2023-2024. The maximum travel expenditure amount for SY2022-2023 is \$250,000.00, of which, \$48,227.05 has been spent and \$22,169.75 is encumbered as of "03/09/2023".

1. Continued:

TRAVEL AND RELATED EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT

WHEREAS, The Board of Education recognizes school staff and Board members will incur travel expenses related to and within the scope of their current responsibilities and for travel that promotes the delivery of instruction or furthers the efficient operation of the school district;

AND, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A Subchapter 7 requires Board members to receive approval of these expenses by a majority of the full voting membership of the Board and staff members to receive prior approval of these expenses by the Superintendent of Schools and a majority of the full voting membership of the Board;

AND, a board of education may establish, for regular district business travel only, an annual school year threshold of \$150 per staff member or district board of education member where prior Board approval shall not be required unless this annual threshold for a staff member is exceeded in a given school year (July 1 through June 30);

AND, travel and related expenses not in compliance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A Subchapter 7 but deemed by the board of education to be necessary and unavoidable as noted on the approved Board of Education Out-of-District Travel and Reimbursement Forms;

NOW BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Education approves all travel not in compliance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A Subchapter 7 as being necessary and unavoidable as noted on the approved Board of Education Out-of-District Travel and Reimbursement Forms; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Education includes in the tentative budget travel and related expense reimbursements in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A Subchapter 7, to a maximum expenditure of \$250,000.00 for all staff and board members for SY2023-2024.

The School Business Administrator/Board Secretary shall track and record these costs to ensure that the maximum amount is not exceeded.

2. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-5.2, BE IT RESOLVED that the Linden Board of Education hereby establishes the following maximums for the 2023-2024 school year, and that the School Business Administrator track and record these costs to ensure that the maximum amount is not exceeded as follows:
