SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT:

Dr. Robertozzi thanked the High School Orchestra for playing in the lobby tonight.

There was a good opening to the school year. There was a lot of maintenance work done over the summer.

Yesterday, September 23, 2013, we accomplished a major hurdle in our technology one to one initiative. Every teacher received a Mac AirBook which will be utilized for instruction. Elementary students in grades three through five will be, by mid October, utilizing one to one Mac AirBooks in the classroom, and in January we will be giving every middle school student in the district a Mac AirBook. There will be parent nights scheduled in November and December for middle school parents to learn about what we're doing. Next year we will launch this initiative at the high school. The reason for this initiative is that we believe it will improve student achievement by integrating 21st century skills into the classroom.

For the first time in Linden High School history, we had two students, Joanna Zalewski and Olivia Podsiebierski, both juniors, win the Union County Tournament in tennis at their respective positions last Friday. They each won straight sets and it is the first time in Linden High School history that this feat has been accomplished. They were not asked to come tonight because Dr. Robertozzi believes that when the state competitions begin, they will accomplish more. They will be recognized at a future meeting.

On behalf of the entire Board and High School Principal, Mrs. Modrak, Dr. Robertozzi and Mr. Topoleski recognized one of our world class athletes Matthew Tohon, Linden High School junior and highly decorated athlete. This past July in Rochester, Minnesota, Matthew had some tremendous accomplishments competing in the National Junior Disabilities Championships. He received a gold medal in the 800 meter wheelchair race; silver medal in the 200 meter wheelchair race and bronze medals for the 400 and 100 meter wheelchair races. He also received a bronze medal for the 50 meter distance competition in archery. Additionally he received a certificate of

participation for the Junior International Wheelchair and Amputee Sports that took place in August in Puerto Rico and as a sophomore in Linden High School, he won four silver medals in the 2013 Boys Wheelchair Track State Championships. He won silver medals in the 100, 400, 800 and 1600, and this year we expect that they will be gold medals.
