Grant will support the on-going work of local non-profits that provide services while preventing, preparing for, and responding to the current COVID-19 pandemic. It will assist them with expenses in their effort to reopen or remain open safely during the pandemic. To qualify for this grant each eligible applicant must:

Have an office physically located and operated in the County of Union;

Have evidence that the organization serves County of Union residents;

Have evidence of local needs specific to COVID-19 impacts;

Be operating and registered with the State of New Jersey as a 501(C)(3); and

Disclose if it has received any other CARES funds, how much was allocated, and what the funds were expended on.
